Nominees must:

- 1 Be a member of an FMC Member Club or an FMC Individual Supporter.
- 2 Consent to the nomination and have the time, passion and skills for the role.
- 3 Provide a profile and pitch (max 250 words), including a photograph of themselves in the outdoors, for publication on the FMC website to enable informed voting.
- 4 Existing Executive members must submit a report of what they have achieved for FMC in the last year.

Nominations must be submitted by email. All nominations must be received by 5:00pm on 7 April 2021. If an election is required polling will close on 19 May 2021.
